



Figure 1, Efficiency




Figure 2, Power dissipation





Figure 3, Input V-I, Iout=40A

Figure 4, 25% - 50% load dynamic




Figure 5, 50% - 75% load dynamic




Figure 6, Output voltage established (Iout = 40A)




Figure 7, Output ripple & noise (Iout = 40A)




Figure 8, Boot delay time (Iout = 40A)






Figure 9, Short-circuit & Output voltage (Iout = 40A)









### **Input Undervoltage Protection**

The converter will shut down after the input voltage drops below the under-voltage protection threshold for shutdown. The converter will start to work again after the input voltage reaches the input under voltage protection threshold for startup. For the Hysteresis, see the Protection characteristics.

#### **Output Overcurrent Protection**

The converter equipped with current limiting circuitry can provide protection from an output overload or short circuit condition. If the output current exceeds the output overcurrent protection set point, the converter enters hiccup mode. When the fault condition is removed, the converter will automatically restart.

### **Overtemperature Protection**

A temperature sensor on the converter senses the average temperature of the module. It protects the converter from being damaged at high temperatures. When the temperature exceeds the over temperature protection threshold, the output will shut down. It will allow the converter to turn on again when the temperature of the sensed location falls by the value of Over temperature Protection Hysteresis

### **Wiring Instructions**

The input and output of this product is terminals. The user should ensure that the input and output wires and terminals are connected reliably, and pay attention to the wire diameter to meet the requirements of the power supply current. If the cable to be used is long, it needs Considering the voltage drop of the wire, if the voltage drop is too large, the voltage output at the load end may not meet the load demand. In this case, consider using a thicker wire diameter or reducing the length of the wire. Generally, if long wiring is required. Long line should be used on the side where the current is relatively small. For example, this product is a step-down product, so long lines should be used on the input side.









## **Thermal Consideration**

Sufficient airflow should be provided to help ensure reliable operating of the WG-24S13R840

Therefore, thermal components are mounted on the top surface of the WG-24S13R840 to dissipate heat to the surrounding environment by conduction, convection, and radiation. Proper airflow can be verified by measuring the temperature at the middle of the base plate.
